Further Information

Smoother Start Program (Orientation Week)	Two weeks before the semester begins, the International Office offers a special introductory week for exchange students. Besides a German intensive course, the program includes an intercultural training about "Living and Studying in Germany". Students also receive support in dealing with organisational matters. After having completed the programme, students should be equipped with all the important information about living and studying in Vechta.
Mentoring Programme - VIP	The international mentoring programme VIP (Vechta's International Programme) aims to support students who are not familiar with Vechta and/or studying in Germany by providing them with a personal mentor. The mentors are students at the University of Vechta themselves. International students can contact them with questions, challenges and problems; their mentors will help them overcome the initial culture shock and show them life and culture in Germany from their own perspective.
ERASMUS- Initiative InterMento	The local ERASMUS-Initiative InterMento organises different activities such as excursions to the climbing park, visits to museums, parties and game nights. International students can get to know Vechta and the German culture while meeting students who are interested in intercultural exchange.

Brown Bag Lunch	During a Brown Bag Lunch, international students present their home country and their home university. Furthermore, they prepare traditional food for the audience to taste.
University Cinema	The International Office, in cooperation with other university institutions, regularly organises screenings of culturally interesting and current films.
