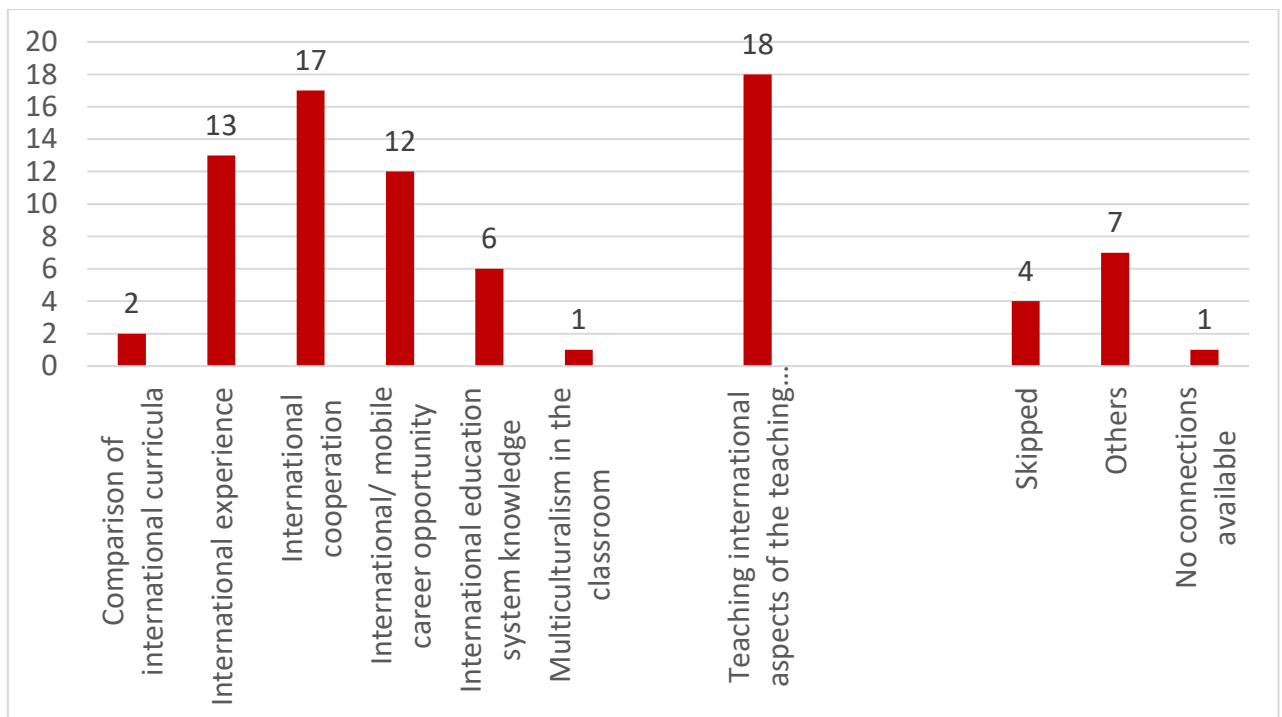


## Survey for primary school teacher trainees

Answers: 81

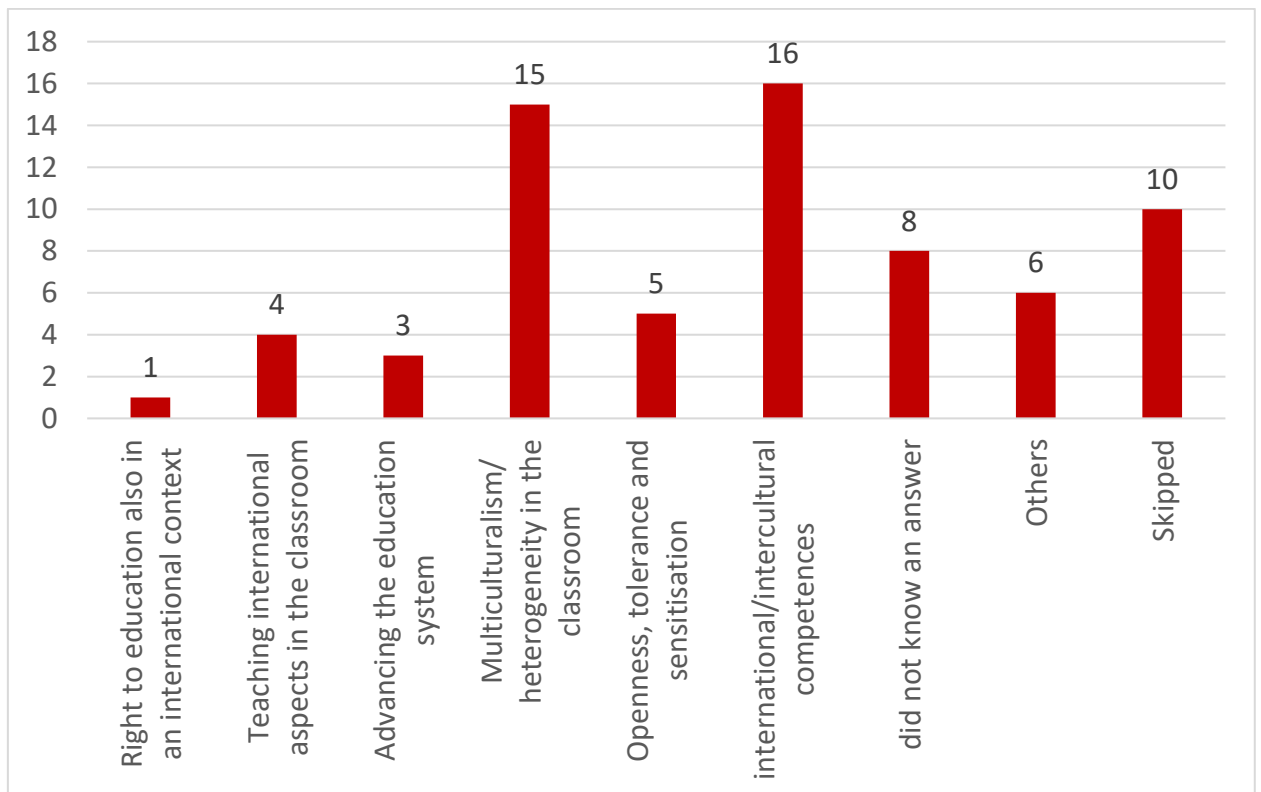


Other: Global Association; Inclusion, Diversity and Equality; German as a Foreign Language; Cultural Diversity in Staff Study Staff and Choice of Topics.

Answers: 68

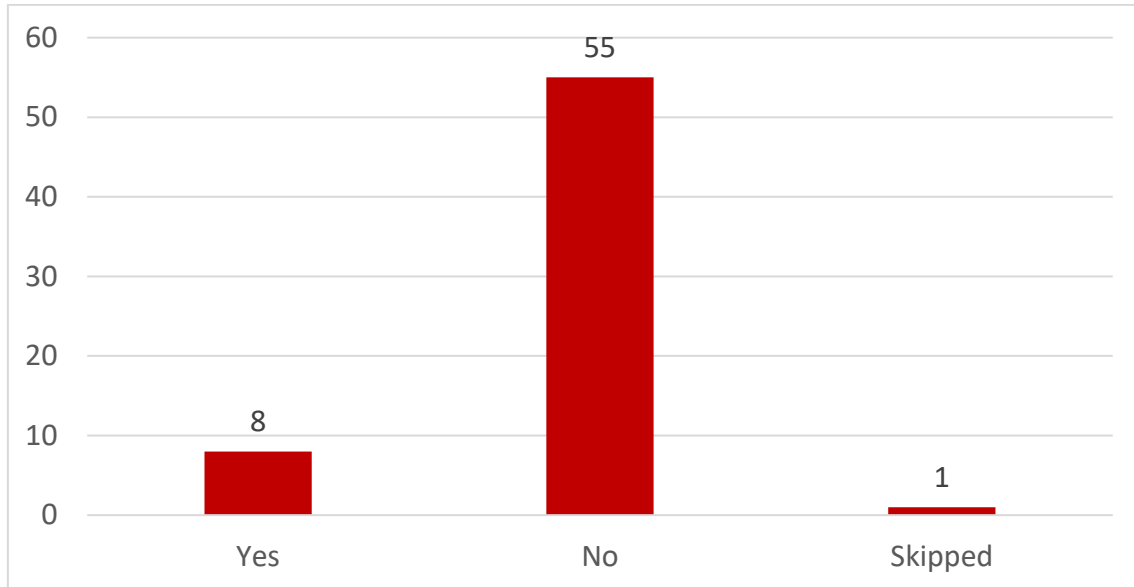

Participants: 65

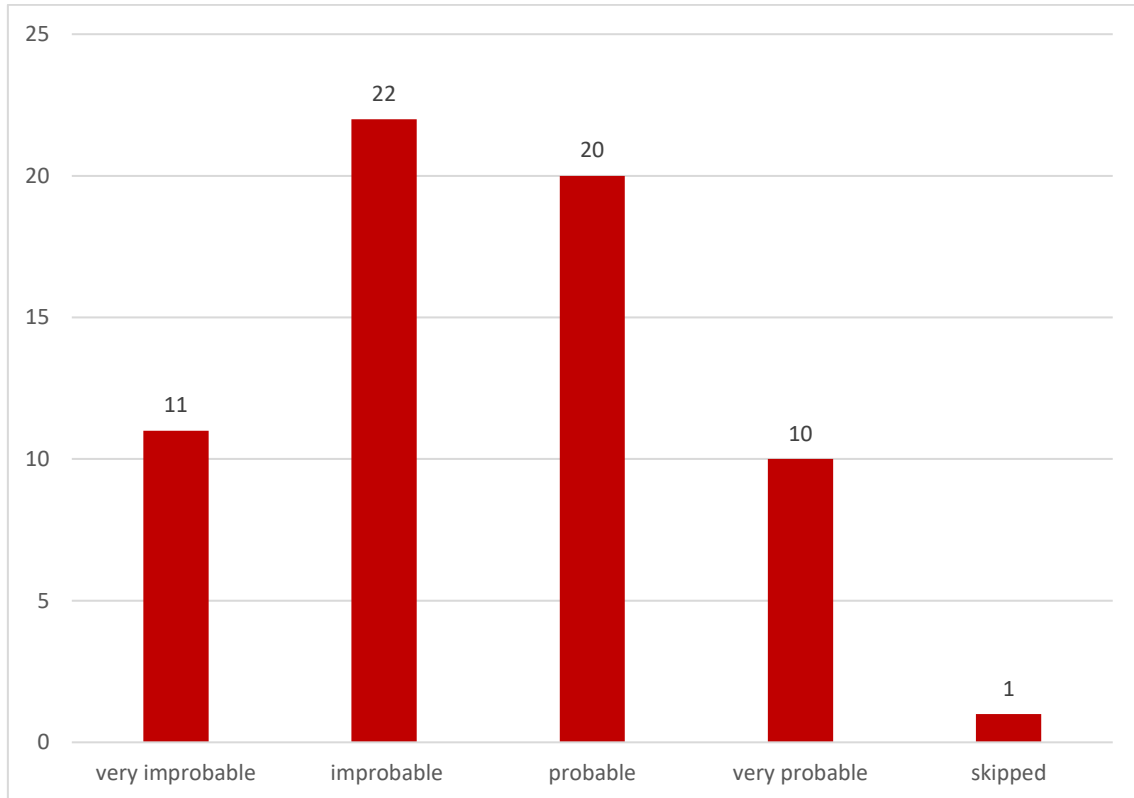

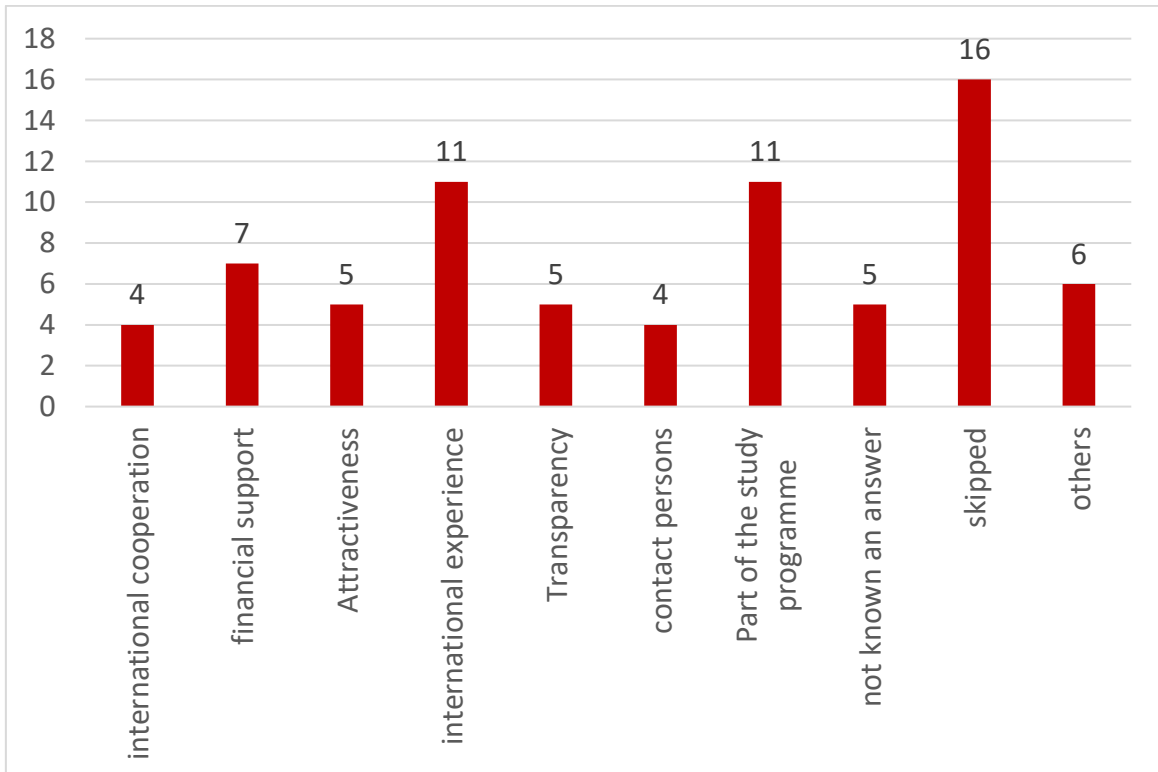
